Step 2: Take the HOC Entry Screening Test. While attending the orientation, you will sign up for an Entry Screening Test. This is a basic test that covers 7th and 8th grade levels of English and math. You will need to pass this test with a minimum score of 70% to be *eligible* for registration. The test will be offered several times the week of June 27, 2016. You will then be notified by email of your score. The top scores will be given a registration appointment time.

Step 3: Come to the Health Occupations Center at your appointed registration time. Registration will begin the week of July 18, 2016.
