Transfers from another California Community College

If you are a transferring student athlete from another California Community College and competed in an intercollegiate sport, please complete the following form and return to Heidi Holmquist, the Athletic Eligibility Specialist.

CCCAA Bylaw 1.10.1

A student transferring to a California community college for athletic participation purposes whose last competition in COA sanctioned intercollegiate athletics was at another California community college must complete 12 units in residence prior to the beginning of the semester/quarter of competition for that college. (See Bylaw 1.5 for definition of "season of competition.") Transfer status is determined by where the athlete last competed, not necessarily where the student last attended.

Please read the following statements and check off the boxes if you understand what is required of you to become eligible At Grossmont College.

If you competed in intercollegiate athletics at another California Community College you must complete at least **12 units** prior to your season of competition. A maximum of **8 units** may be taken during the summer.

If you are expecting to meet the residency requirement, **all 12 units** must be at Grossmont College and not any other community college, which includes Cuyamaca College.

You must have a cumulative Grade Point Average of 2.0 or higher since the first semester you competed.
