Afterward, you will write a 1-2 page reflection (typed, double-spaced) on this event by answering the following questions:

- 1. Describe the event and your initial expectation of participating in the event. Include what you did to prepare, if anything (e.g. research homelessness in San Diego).
- 2. Describe what you did, and how you felt about the activity: what emotions did you feel before, during and after the activity?
- 3. Compare/contrast your initial expectations to your experiences. Have these expectations changed? Why/why not?
- 4. Briefly relate your experience to one of the models in your text that explain why people help: was your behavior better explained by the egoistic model, the evolutionary model, or the empathy-altruism model? Explain.
