## Answers from the California Community College RP Group 2013 Study:




Survey: 785 students (12 CCCs)

- 36% current students, 32% completers, 32% leavers
- 30% first generation
- 32% white, 31% Latino, 25% African American, 12% other


### CCSSE BENCHMARKS FOR EFFECTIVE EDUCATIONAL PRACTICE

- 40 randomly selected sections



#### FOCUS GROUP PARTICIPANTS




