A. Announcements

Chris announced that nominations for the Distance Education Coordinator position are now open until the next senate meeting on October 20.

B. Distinguished Faculty recognition

College president Sunny Cooke presented the Distinguished Faculty award for 2008-09 to Edda Temoche-Weldele from the Foreign Language Department.

C. Colleague Resolution presentation

Chris thanked Laura Burger for her work on the senate's resolution of appreciation to various service areas for the herculean efforts in implementing the Colleague record system. Laura and Chris presented framed copies of the resolution to representatives from the following campus areas: Information Systems, Admissions and Records, Instructional Operations, the instructional deans and their administrative assistants, Counseling, EOPS, Learning Technology and Resources, Disabled Students Programs and Services, the cashiers office, Associate Students of Grossmont College, Student Affairs, Business Communications and Financial Aid.

D. Selection of Student Success Faculty Co-chair

Chris reported that there were two nominees for the position for Student Success Committee faculty co-chair: Sue Jensen (English) and Rafael Gutierrez (Biology). Ballots were distributed and cast. The senate officers will confirm the validity of each ballot as being from a senator and report the results later.

IV. ACTION ITEMS

A. Committee Appointments

A list of faculty members appointed to various campus committees was included in the agenda. A motion was made to approve the appointments.

B. BP/AP 4250 – Probation, Disqualification, & Readmission

A revised copy of Board Policy and Administrative Procedure 4250 were provided with the agenda. Chris explained the primary differences between the original and revised policies. A motion was made to approve the revisions to Board Policy and Administrative Procedures 4250.

V. INFORMATION ITEMS

A. Balloting System proposal (handout)

Chris introduced a proposal to adopt an electronic balloting system for senate elections.

A motion was made to suspend the rules to take action on a proposal to adopt an electronic balloting system.

M/S/C Lehman/Milroy (39 in favor, 3 opposed, 7 abstentions)

A motion was made to approve the senate's use of an electronic voting system. M/S/U Burger/Atchison

During the ensuing discussion the following issues were discussed: reasons for switching (Chris indicated the time involved and the amount of paper products wasted), security of the system (Jeff provided detail on the typical security processes), questions on inclusion of write-in provision (some systems allow it, typically at a higher cost and some do not), total cost to the senate of the systems (options range from approximately \$300 to \$2,000 with both subscription and per-election options available). Following the discussion, a motion was made to add an amendment that requires the voting system to include an option for write-in candidates.

B. Resolution to Support Inclusion of Part-time Faculty
