AOJ 158 Emergency Dispatch Operator is a one-time certificate course. We used to offer this each semester, then we reduced it to once per year. Now it has not been offered for 2 years. When a police department hires a police dispatcher, the dispatcher must obtain a certificate in this course within one year of being hired. This course is not being offered anywhere in SD County! It is a matter of public safety to offer this course. Since it is .5170 LED, by offering it, we are sacrificing two of our high wait-listed core degree program courses but we really need to offer it. Right now, we can only offer it if Prop 30 passes and the Enrollment Strategies Committee approves.

AOJ 207 is a required course for our Security Management degree and it has not been offered for 2 years! We have been modifying this course with other core AOJ courses but since there is such a high wait list on even the core courses, students are having a hard time finishing their Security Mgmt degree. This course needs to be offered soon to allow students in this degree program to graduate.

AOJ 100 & 101 is similar to the Emergency Dispatch course in that many law enforcement employees need this certificate course to do their job... it is required for SD County Probation Officers. Miramar dropped this course at the last minute this fall, leaving dozens of probation officers without this required course. Again, it is a state mandate, certificate course, rather than a part of our degree programs. We are offering these courses in the spring regardless if Prop 30 passes or not but we sacrificed some core courses to do so.

- Bio 140: No identified add backs at this time.
