Tips for Successful Learning in Introduction to Physical Geography

To successfully meet the objectives of Introduction to Physical Geography, it is crucial that students actively partake in the following:

- 1. Take good notes during lecture.
- 2. After <u>each</u> lecture, <u>review notes</u> and <u>GENERATE QUESTIONS</u> about the topics that might be confusing to you or that need more clarification/explanation.
- 3. Bring questions from #2 to class and <u>ask them</u> during the QnA session at the first 5 minutes of each class.
- 4. <u>Read</u> the assigned sections of your book at the assigned times in the class schedule and <u>generate</u> <u>questions</u> from your reading. Bring those questions to class as well and ask them during the QnA session.
- 5. Obtain and answer the <u>review questions</u> from the class website each week. If you are having trouble with one or more of the questions, get help right away.
- 6. Review the supplemental content on the <u>class website</u> (In the section titled, "*This Week in Physical Geography*") daily to augment your learning of topics discussed in lecture. In addition, review each handout from the <u>handout packet</u> after we discuss them. <u>Generate questions</u> from these reviews.
- 7. Thoroughly examine the <u>Exam study guide</u> online to insure that you have a solid understanding of all topics within. <u>Generate questions</u> from those topics you are uncertain about.
- 8. For <u>all of the questions that you generate</u> from above, <u>utilize as many of the following resources as necessary</u> to get answers to your questions and to insure that your level of understanding meets the objectives of the course:
 - A. Use the **QnA** session (First 5 minutes of class).
 - B. Ask questions during lecture as topics are being discussed.
 - C. Use the <u>online class discussion forum.</u>
 - D. Send questions via email to instructor.
 - E. Ask questions via phone/voicemail.
 - F. Utilize instructor office hours to ask questions and get clarification.
 - G. Make an appointment with a tutor in the <u>Tutoring Center</u> for additional help. (Geography Tutor = Dalene Early) (Available M-Th, 11am to 3pm)
 - H. Use the lecture notes, book, handouts, and class website as a source of answers to your questions.
