SDSU accepts AA-T degrees in Communication Studies (for the Communication BA in Applied Arts and Health Communication BS in Applied Arts only). These specific degrees will not have a foreign language requirement at SDSU. Candidates for the Communication BA degree in Applied Arts must satisfy competency in mathematics by completing three semesters of college mathematics or a statistical sequence. Completion of Math 160 or Anth/Bio/Psy/Soc 215 is recommended. Check with a Counselor for applicability to other CSU's. The Communication Studies AA-T requires a minimum 2.75 Cumulative G.P.A.

Students applying with the AA-T in Communication Studies will receive priority in the admissions process but are not guaranteed admittance into the CSU of their choice.

Admission is highly competitive for most CSU's. Students are strongly advised to go above and beyond minimum G.P.A requirements and apply for admission at multiple campuses.

The Health Communications B.S. degree in Applied Arts and Sciences does not have a foreign language or math competency requirement.
