SDSU accepts AA-T degrees in Geography (for the Geography BA in Applied Arts - Foundations of Geography Emphasis only). This specific BA degree will not have a foreign language requirement at SDSU. Check with a Counselor for applicability to other CSU's. The Geography AA-T requires a minimum 2.0 Cumulative G.P.A.

Students applying with the AA-T in Geography will receive priority in the admissions process but are not guaranteed admittance into the CSU of their choice.

Admission is highly competitive for most CSU's. Students are strongly advised to go above and beyond minimum G.P.A requirements and apply for admission at multiple campuses.
