### Spanish - B.A. DEGREE

To receive admission preference to CSU's students can complete the AA-T in Spanish. It is also important that students incorporate as much of the lower division course work found on the [www.ASSIST.org](http://www.ASSIST.org) articulation agreement as possible. In addition to degree requirements, students must complete CSU GE Certification or IGETC-CSU. It is important to meet with a Counselor for additional assistance.
