*CSU AMERICAN INSTITUTION (AI) - 2 COURSES (6 UNITS)
THE AI REQUIREMENT IS A CSU GRADUATION REQUIREMENT. Completion is not mandatory for admission, however, completion of this requirement prior to transfer is highly recommended. Students are advised to select two of the three Area D (above) requirements from this section. Select track 1, 2 or 3 and complete an A and B course.
Courses above that have been bolded and underlined may be used to meet both American Institutions and Area D requirements.
TRACK 1: One course from A and one from B

TRACK 3: One course from $A$ and one from $B$
A: HIST 123, 124, POSC 121, 140

Additional Option: AP US History (Score of 3 or higher) plus HIST 123 or 124 or POSC 121 or 140

6A: Language Other Than English (UC Requirement Only) - Students must meet one of the options below. Must be verifiable by official records on high school transcripts or by exam scores sent to Grossmont College Admissions and Records.

1. Completion of one of the folowing courses or higher will meet the UC language proficiency requirement:

ASL 120, ARBC 120, CHIN 120, FREN 120, GERM 120, ITAL 120, JAPN 120, RUSS 120, SPAN 120
2. Two (2) years of high school coursework in the same foreign language with a grade of "C-" or higher.
3. Achieve a score of 3 or higher on the College Board Advanced Placement Exam in a language other than English.
4. Achieve a score of 500-540 (depending on the language-verify with counselor) on the SAT II: Subject Test in Langugaes other than English
5. Achieve a score of 5 or higher on the International Baccalaureate Higher Level Examinations in a language other than English. English "O" level exams (score of "A," "B" or "C") and English International "A" exams (score of 5, 6 or 7) are also accepted.
6. Documented satisfactory completion of 2 or more years of formal schooling at the 6 th grade level or higher in an institution where the language of instruction is not English. Must earn a grade of " C " or higher.
7. Statement from a foreign language instructor (must be an original copy on official college/university letterhead) documenting proficiency.

IGETC may not clear all general education requirements and is not recommended for all majors.
All courses must be completed with a "C" or better. "D" or "C-" grades are not acceptable for IGETC.
Courses can be certified in only one area.
Fulfillment of IGETC does not guarantee admission.
Courses may be taken with a "P" (Pass) but both the CSU and UC systems have a limit on the number of units.
Students must request official certification of IGETC in Admissions and Records/Evaluations.
Consult with a Counselor to determine how external exam scores (AP and IB) are applied to meet IGETC areas.
*Indicates that transfer credit may be limited by either UC or CSU or both.
