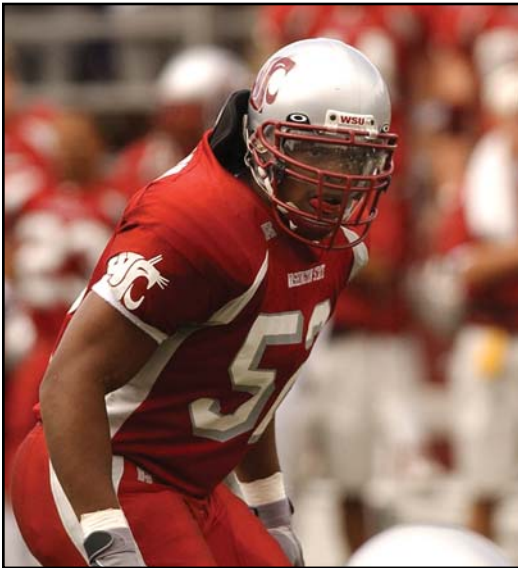


**Grossmont College

Grossmont's base defense is a 3-4 with the capabilities to change easily to a 4-3 if needed due to a lack of linebackers or more strength in the D line. Grossmont was matched up with what was "tagged" the "Super 7 Conference," the best in California. Grossmont was weakened a little offensively in '09 due to the loss of two starting QB's but the defense for the most part held its own as shown in some stats below.
