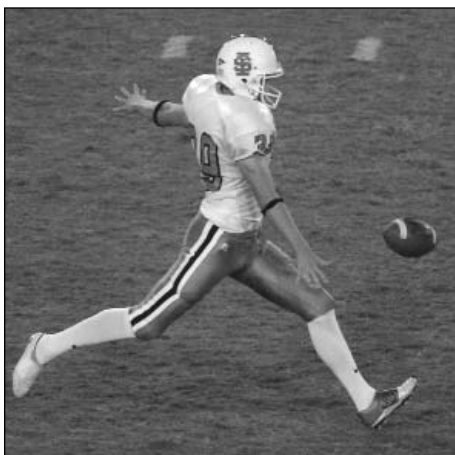

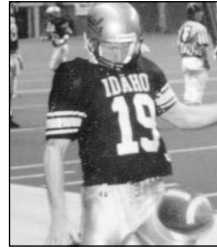
**Jared Ballman (P)**

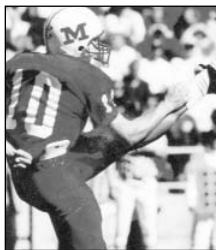
**MIKE O'NEAL - 1997**  
A graduate of St. Augustine HS, Mike received a scholarship to U. of Idaho after his freshman year and became a starting punter in 1998. He has one of Grossmont's all-time best punt averages. He had three successful years at Idaho before graduating in 2000.



**ASEN ASPARUHOF - 1998**  
Asen came in from Bulgaria, never having been on a football field. He did our kickoffs and learned to do field goals. His very strong leg was noticed by Fresno State. They gave him a full scholarship after his freshman year and he became one of the top kickers in the USA. He didn't pursue a pro career for personal reasons.



**KEVIN BRENNAN - 1996**  
A graduate of Chula Vista HS, Kevin scholarshiped to Liberty College. He transferred to Portland State and became a starter. He was a big part of a successful '96 season. He made three game winning field goals.

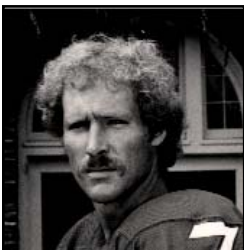


**JASON CHENEY - 1993**

**CLAY PERKINS 2003**  
A graduate of West Hills HS, Clay came in with zero punting experience but went out as one of the best in the state. He had a "big" impact in the state playoffs (03). He threw a pass on a fake punt that set up the winning TD in the quarter finals, and then with only 1 minutes left in the championship game against San Francisco, punted 45 yards to the 3 yard line. Clay finished his career at Harding University.

**KEN WILSON**

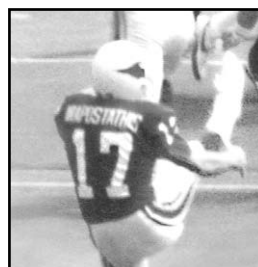

Grossmont's All Time Best - 1980-81



Brad was a great soccer player at Grossmont High School. He came to Grossmont and learned to kickoff. He continued this when he transferred to UCLA. When he was picked up by the New York Giants, he began kicking field goals and became one of the best in the NFL over a 10-year career. He's now in charge of Grossmont's very successful annual Brad Daluiso Golf Tournament.



**EVAN ARAPOSTHESIS**

Out of Monte Vista HS, to Eastern Illinois, Evan was one of the Griffs' all time best kickers. He spent three years with the Arizona Cardinals as their punter.



**LANCE ORTEGA**

A fine kicker out of Mt. Miguel HS, kicked for Western Michigan U. He became a top notch competitor. He now has a successful kicking camp and has trained Griffin kickers.



**DAN MELVILLE**

Out of El Capitan HS, to U. of California, then to San Francisco 49'ers. He still holds the Griffin punt avg. record after 30 years (43.3).
