ACADEMIC/VOCATIONAL GRANT PROGRAM 1812 Scholarship

ALL GRANTS:

You must be a resident within the jurisdiction of El Cajon Elks Lodge 1812. (Contact Lodge for verification).

You must be a citizen of the United States when you apply.

The application form requires you to summarize the costs of your planned program, and to summarize your financial ability to pay these costs.

Your completed application and brochure must be returned to the El Cajon Elks Lodge #1812. 4.

Grant Scholarships may be awarded for up to two full years if the progress and conduct of the applicant justifies the continuation of the scholarship.

All scholarships are granted in the form of Certificates of Award. No funds will be given directly to the student. 6.

When the student is properly enrolled and accepted, the school is to notify El Cajon Elks lodge of the payments that need to be paid. The Scholarship Fund will then reimburse the school.

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS:

1. You must have a plan to pursue an academic degreefrom an accredited institution where you will earn an Associate Degree, and/or a Diploma, and/or Certificate of Completion within the next two years.

2. The definition of an eligible program shall be comparable to that contained in the Federal Academic Program, culminating in an Associates Degree; Diploma, or Certificate, but less than a Baccalaureate Program. A student should plan to carry a minimum load of 12 semester credit hours each term, or verification of full time enrollment, enrolling in a 4-year course leading to a Bachelor's Degree are not eligible to apply.

VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS:

 You must have a plan to pursue a vocational/technical program in a qualified school or training facility where you will earn an Associate Degree, a Diploma, or a Certificate of Completion within the next two years.

2. The definition of an eligible program shall be comparable to that contained in the Federal Vocational/Technical Program, culminating in an Associates Degree, Diploma, or Certificate, but less than a Baccalaureate Program. A student should plan to carry a minimum load of 12 semester credit hours each term, or verification of full time enrollment. Applicants enrolling in a 4-year course leading to a Bachelor's Degree are NOT eligible to apply.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

ALL APPLICANTS MUST BE 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER

BROCHURE PREPARATION AND REQUIREMENTS-APPLICATION:

Applicant must use the official Elks form (no photocopies accepted), which has been dated and signed by the applicant. Typewritten applications and statements are preferred.

EXHIBITS

Should be neat, concise and in chronological order. Letters of endorsement, etc., should be removed from envelope and bound flat, (allow sufficient margin on left border for readability).

ORDER OF EXHIBITS

Completed application form.

- Applicant's statement summarizing the accomplishments, needs, and objectives that qualifies the applicant for a scholarship.
- Parent's or friend's description of the family's situation. number of children at home, and the need for a scholarship.
- Brief letters of endorsement from responsible persons who are neither a relative nor an educator. These letters should describe the applicant's character, industry, disposition, and worthiness (3-letter limit).

Brief letters from educators describing the applicant's general ability, work habits leadership, personality, and integrity. (2 letter limit).

6. Documents showing school grades or work records of the past two years must be submitted. (Armed forces records, vocational records, and aptitude test scores may be included).

Application and all other documents must be placed in proper order and securely stapled together so that all documents can be read without removing the bindings. Elaborate bindings or bulky covers should not be used.

Qualifying applicants will be interviewed by the trustees of the Scholarship Grant within 30 days of receipt.

Applicants will be judged on:

- a. General worthiness and desire.
- Financial need and resourcefulness. b.
- Aptitude toward chosen vocation. c. ď.
- Grades and test scores in schools
- Completeness of the brochure. Informal interview with Trustees.

THE APPLICATION AND OTHER DOCUMENTS MUST BE

- In original form (not photocopied) properly signed and dated.
- Written in English on 8 1/2 x 11 size pages, one side only.

Typed, if possible.

- Roved form envelopes
