- Be a first-time college student (includes dual enrollment or concurrent high school students) and a California resident or AB540 eligible
- Review and sign the Promise Pledge
- Complete and submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid FAFSA or California Dream Act application
- Complete the college onboarding process at Grossmont or Cuyamaca College: Application, Orientation, Assessment, and Education Plan. For additional assistance, watch this video to help you complete the online orientation and abbreviated education plan.
- Attend as a full-time student at Grossmont or Cuyamaca College (At least 12 credit units per semester)
- Maintain a 2.0 college grade point average or higher to remain eligible

*DISCLAIMERS: Grossmont-Cuyamaca College Promise covers tuition (enrollment) fees and mandatory fees (student health, representation, and Cuyamaca construction fee). Books, supplies, parking permits, and other class fees are not included, although additional financial support may be available through financial aid for eligible students. If you start in the spring semester, only spring fees will be covered.*
